Tuesday

Making Mandalas: Find your inner peace with colorful Mandalas from the many countries of the Eastern world. Learn about its meaning and relations to math and science. Begin your own personal mandala to take home! Max enrollment: 50; \$30

Wednesday

Hands on Pottery: Use different painting techniques including stencils, fun writers and tape to design and paint your one of a kind cereal or ice cream bowl. Pieces are glazed and fired at the Hands on Pottery studio and returned to school. Max enrollment: 50; \$45

Thursday

Spring Into Art: Create art masterpieces using unusual techniques and unorthodox tools, like salad spinners, balls and kitchen utensils. You'll be amazed at what you create! *Note: There will not be indoor sports activities on Thursday, weather permitting, we may use the playground.

Friday

Paint Play: This isn't your every day painting class. Explore different elements for paint on a variety of mediums – from tin foil, to sand paper using a variety of materials including from magnets to every day items. Max enrollment: 50; \$35
