<b>Acting Studio</b>	Play theater games and establish the building blocks to improvisation and drama. Design scenery and props and write your very own script to perform in front of family and friends. Focus of this class is freeing the creative spirit, building ensembles, and exploring the imagination.
<b>Chess</b>	All levels welcome. New players welcome to learn how to play a full game of chess and how to write down moves to learn from mistakes. Experienced players learn strategies and tactics to help improve their game. All players will learn about the etiquette and strategy of a game that is truly a great lifetime activity for young and old alike.
<b>Cool Concoctions</b>	Discover the basics of solids, liquids, and gases, as well as in-between states of matter as we create our own flubber, play dough, worms, and more! We'll also make some concoctions such as our own paint and try them out on some great craft activities!
<b>Crochet Away!</b>	Learn to crochet bracelets, hearts, bows, butterflies and flowers working our way up to baby hats which will be donated to hospital NICUs for premature babies.
<b>Intro to Fencing</b>	Learn the basics of fencing in this introductory class. Classes will cover footwork, bladework and bouting tactics. Students will improve their speed, reaction time and fence competitive bouts every class. Helmets and plastic blades will be provided.
<b>Karate</b>	Begin your martial arts journey! In this class, students will experience training that improves their physical conditioning and affords them practical self-defense skills. They will also learn the way of the noble hero and the meaning of responsible action. With this traditional martial arts training, the goal is to develop the whole person - body, mind, and character. Studying martial arts increases one's confidence, focus, self-discipline, self-control, and respect for self and others. Students begin with a white belt and, if the opportunity is earned, may test for belt advancement at session end for a \$50 test fee coordinated by, payable to, and held at the Kempo Karate of Darien dojo.
<b>Math Olympiad</b>	Join other mathletes and work together to compete in four national math problem solving contests from November to March. Students meet weekly to practice for the contests, During class, students are introduced to important mathematical concepts and learn major strategies and develop mathematical flexibility in problem solving. This class runs from October 16 to March 25 and is great for all levels of Math students in grades 4 and 5.
<b>Morning Basketball</b>	Play some hoops before the school day starts in this fun, non-competitive environment. Learn basketball skills---ball handling, dribbling and shooting--and play scrimmages against friends.
<b>Morning Sports</b>	Get a jump start on your day and burn off all that energy BEFORE you go to school. Variety of sports each week, including basketball, soccer, capture the flag and more!
<b>My First Hot Cocoa Stand</b>	Come learn how to make yummy hot cocoa and how to earn money selling it! A hot cocoa stand is a great way to introduce young entrepreneurs to the world of business! This program empowers kids with an entrepreneurial mindset for their "business," drawing from such disciplines as marketing, finance and strategy, in a supportive environment fostering team work. From designing marketing flyers to estimating profits to experimenting with recipes, students have fun while developing business savvy!
<b>Ninja Boot Camp</b>	Sneak in to the gym after school and transform in to a Ninja in training! Use your Ninja stealth and speed as you work your way through different stations that test your strength, endurance and flexibility while maintaining your Ninja cool.
<b>Painting Play and Clay Fun</b>	Have fun with the artwork you create! We will explore different types of paint, ways to apply it (fingers included!), and different surfaces to apply it to. With clay, students will be able to make various creations out of different types of clay including model magic, stoneware, polymer, and more! This class is a wonderful place to explore your creative side! Smocks from home are appreciated, and recommended.
<b>Photography</b>	Attention young shutterbugs! In this eye-opening adventure into the world of photography, you'll learn the tricks of the trade, just like the pros use! From blue skies and green trees to friendly smiles and sandaled feet you'll capture it all for your very own portfolio. And because all young stars deserve their time to shine, we'll conclude with a gallery to show off your artistic images to friends and family! Cameras are provided for the children to use during each class.
<b>Robotics with EV3 Mindstorms</b>	Begin exploring robots by building a few. This design and engineering class focuses building and animating robots with pre-built programs. Results are fast and gratifying! This class encourages the engineer and tinkerer to have fun, play and build. Students take home pictures of their creations.
<b>SNAX!</b>	Calling all mini-chefs! Kids will make exciting no-bake snacks--some will be savory and others sweet. Students will also learn culinary skills such as chopping, mixing and emulsifying as well as proper food handling. Cooks will get to sample what they make each session. Note: Nuts, Eggs, Soy, and Wheat may be used in all recipes.
